A Japanese cloisonné vase, Meiji period, of shouldered tapering form, decorated with birds and wisteria above other flowers, height 30.5cm (dent and enamel loss to reverse), together with two Japanese Satsuma vases, heights 12cm and 12.5cm (one with repaired neck).

Condition Report

1294. Cloisonne vase - large dent, chip and enamel loss to shoulder on reverse (approx 4cm x 4cm), otherwise typical surface scratches and wear. Small hairlines to foot.

Satsuma vase - good condition, typical light crazing, minor wear to gilt.

Satsuma vase - damage and repaired rim, typical surface scratches and wear to gilt, otherwise ok.
