An unusual late 18th/early 19th century flintlock blunderbuss pistol or dragon with flared steel barrel, barrel length 25cm, detailed with proof mark 'Griez', shaped lock, also detailed 'Griez', steel trigger guard and butt plate, full-stocked with pull-out steel ramrod. Provenance: the property of a Hampshire private collector.

Condition Report

4518. The blunderbuss appears original but has been heavily cleaned back in the past., with evidence of old deeper pitted rust to locks. Woodwork generally good, good patina though marked and bruised throughout as you would expect. Action faulty, half cocks but trigger struggles to release. Ramrod appears later. Screw missing from trigger guard.
