4669. Overall this gun has been heavily cleaned at some point. Metalwork areas have heavy old rust pitting around locks and trigger guard area. Timber is generally clean, some minor bruising. Decoration on locks and hammer areas fairly good though has had rust cleaned back in the past. Action works, full and half cock.
