A mid/late 19th century French gilt metal and opaline glass nécessaire, modelled in the form of an egg raised within a cagework stand, the hinged lid opening to reveal scissors, thimble and needle prick, height 12.5cm.

Condition Report

2357. The surface of the glass is a bit dirty and some of the wire is a little misshapen, but otherwise generally good order.

The interior includes the top cap of a needle case, which does not have the main part with it.
