Condition Report

4821. Blade overall evidence of re-sharpening, point blunted slightly, edge of blade with chips more severe towards the point. Hilt with old patinated rust, some patches still active. Replaced corded grip with some remains of the original beneath. Scabbard similar with old patinated rust, one or two spots active in places. Overall an honest sword.
