A rare mid to late 19th century double-barrelled 10-bore percussion sporting gun by William Powell & Son with Damascus steel barrels, barrel length 75.5cm, foliate engraved locks and hammers, walnut stock with chequered grips and steel furniture, and wood ramrod with lead tip (barrels probably shortened). Provenance: the property of a Hampshire private collector.

Condition Report

4512. Overall first appearance, an honest untouched looking gun. Deep patina to wood stock. Some old bruises and marks to stock as you might expect. Steelwork shows old signs of rust with patina. Action works, full and half cock. Probably a later fitted ramrod, if not fully then certainly the tip has been poorly repaired. Some deep pitting to barrel mouth area though patinated now. Cannot give a condition report of barrels.
