Provenance: the property of a Hampshire private collector.

4519. Overall a clean gun. Has been sympathetically cleaned/restored, trigger guard has evidence of old pitting to steel, obvious light bruising as you might expect. Both hammers hold on half and full cock, and release smoothly. Cannot provide a condition report on the barrels.
