A George V silver novelty stamp case in the form of a side table with pierced three-quarter gallery above a simulated drawer, on tapering legs, Birmingham 1911 and 1912 by Lawrence Emanuel, height 3.7cm, a silver sovereign case with reeded decoration, London 1885 by Sampson Mordan & Co, and a silver engine turned curved rectangular card case, Birmingham 1927, total weight 95.9g.

Condition Report

367. Side table stamp case - front right leg with small lead repair. Otherwise generally good condition with only typical light surface scratches. Hinge is good and hallmarks are clear.

Card case - few small dents to front and edge. Engraved monogram, engine turning generally good. Hinge is a little wobbly but closes ok. Good clear hallmarks.

Sovereign case - typical light surface scratches and wear. Engraved monogram. Hinge is good and sprung push button release working, but small gape between sections. Sprung interior good. Good clear hallmarks.
