A French An XI cuirassier's sword with straight single-edged double-fullered blade with unusual hatchet point, blade length 96.5cm, stamped 'AP' mark for Atelier de Précision to hilt end, brass triple-bar hilt, stamped 'Versailles', and moulded leather grip, with steel scabbard with twin suspension rigs (some breakdown to leather grip, active rust and pitting to scabbard).

### Condition Report

4812. Overall a completely untouched sword, looks like a barn find. Scabbard overall heavily pitted, some old and some new active rust in places, brass guard deeply patinated, grip has some woodworm damage to leather work and splits to stitching. Blade has the odd blemish but otherwise very good throughout, could benefit from a clean throughout.
