LOT 574

A Victorian 12ct gold ring, mounted with three oval cut garnets and two pairs of half-pearls, otherwise with engraved decoration, Birmingham 1874, weight 2.1g, ring size approx J1/2.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

One garnet chipped to one side

Slight abrasion to one or two facet edges of each garnet

Glue extensively used to hold one half-pearl in place, this has spilt onto one garnet.

Some wear to collet/claw settings of garnets and half-pearls.

Beaded decoration to sides of mount are heavily worn/lacking on one side.

Resized in the past - date letter of hallmark now lacking, and partial inscription within the shank, largely lost through resizing.

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
