A Victorian gold, yellow diamond, ruby and emerald ring, mounted with an old cut cushion shaped yellow diamond at the centre, Birmingham 1871, ring size approx M1/2.

Condition Report

A few claws have been re-tipped in the past, some of which are silver rather than gold.
Some abrasion to the table facets of the emeralds and rubies.
Typical scratching/wear to shank and setting.
Hallmark is clear - Birmingham 1871 as per description. Maker's mark is not legible
Yellow diamond approx. 3.3mm x 3.4mm x 2.2mm

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
