## LOT 1450

A large Minton Coalbrookdale potpourri and cover, circa 1840, of circular shape with turquoise glazed twisted handles, heavily encrusted and painted with flowers and foliage, the cover pierced with one large central hole and a pattern of smaller holes, unmarked, diameter including handles 29cm (handles restored).

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

Both handles have been cleanly broken away and professionally restored back into position - the handles themselves are fundamentally ok it is purely some minor restoration and re-gilding to the rim of the base which is involved. It is difficult to photograph but if you view image 10 on our website using the zoom function you can just see a small discrepancy in the gilding to the rim running each side of the handle terminal.

Otherwise the base and cover are in good condition overall with some minor professional restoration to some of the flowers and foliage, this is very well executed and not noticeable unless with a trained eye, e.g., to the purple edged flowers on the cover - see image four on our website using the zoom function.
