A large pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware vases, dated 1878, decorated by Frank A. Butler, monogrammed, each with four grey glazed oval head and shoulder portraits within stylized foliate beaded framing and foliage against a ground of manji symbols, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 52cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Both vases are in good condition overall with no cracks or restoration.

Both have some minor chips/nicks to the edges of the portrait panels, and one of the portraits has a small narrow glued repair to its edge approx 1cm long.

Otherwise there are some minor and insignificant losses to the sprigged beadwork/decoration - few and far between and only noticeable on closer inspection.
