## LOT 1633

Three small Meissen floral encrusted pots and covers, circa 1900, with yellow enamelled basketweave moulded details and gilt rims, two of oval shape, length 7cm, and one circular, diameter 9cm, together with two similar Meissen circular pots and covers with floral finials, a Meissen floral painted jug, 18th century, height 12.5cm, a Meissen puce painted caddy, height 10cm, a Meissen potpourri vase and cover, the base with a dog and fowl, height 20cm, and a French faience plate painted with fruit and flowers, diameter 25cm (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £100 - £150

## Condition Report

Pair oval floral encrusted boxes and covers - both fundamentally ok but with losses to the applied flowers and foliage, probably both missing a finial.

Similar circular box and cover - has a chip to the top rim edge of the base but otherwise fundamentally ok with losses/chips to the applied flowers and foliage, which probably includes a finial or little handles.

Pair circular pots and covers - first with old yellowed restoration to top rim edge of base with associated haircrack, and to rim edge of cover, the finial has chips. The second example is missing the stalk of the finial and has minor chips to the petals of the finial.

Jug - small nicks to rim edge of spout, the foot has a rough finish with some fritting which is a manufacturing issue.

Caddy - missing the cover, there is wear to the gilding where the cover would have sat, otherwise ok.

Plate - chip to upper rim edge at 5 o'clock, otherwise ok.

Potpourri with dog - extensively restored overall.
