An early Victorian mahogany apothecary's box, the hinged front enclosing a series of glass bottles and two drawers, the back fitted with a sliding panel revealing further bottles, height 26cm, width 23cm, together with another 19th century medicine box, width 15cm (some replacement bottles).

Condition Report

2612. The exterior is in reasonably good order and does have some minor scuffs and wear. Some of the bottles are replacements and some have chipped rims. There is a divide missing to the centre and there is some oxidizing to the gilt brass.

The other box has a loose handle, but is in generally good order.
