LOT 1620

A Spode Felspar porcelain part service, circa 1820, decorated in pattern No. 4519, with flowers of the union (roses, thistles and shamrock) within foliate scroll moulded rims edged in gilt, comprising fifteen octagonal plates, diameter 22.5cm, four oval dishes 28cm long, and one oval dish 26cm long, printed, impressed and painted marks to bases (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Plates - One of the plates has a small firing crack to the rim edge, otherwise all are in good condition overall with no chips or restoration. There are typical light surface scratches commensurate with age and use, but nothing terrible or untoward. The enamels and gilding remain good.

Dishes - of the four larger dishes, one is a matched example with a slight difference in the enamel colours but is in good condition, one has a firing crack to the footrim which is not visible to the upper surface and one has a haircrack to the rim, the other is in good condition. The smaller dish is ok with some light surface scratches.
