### LOT 1808

A set of five Theresienthal glasses, early 20th century, the ogee bowls enamelled in green and yellow and gilt with foliate wreaths suspended from stylized sunburst panels on a gilt band, with swollen stems and circular feet, height 20cm, together with a set of five smaller Theresienthal glasses enamelled with stylized foliate panels, height 9.2cm (small chip to one of smaller glasses).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

One of the smaller glasses has a small chip to the bowl rim exterior. Each of the small glasses has heavily worn gilding to the rim.

Each of the larger glasses is in good condition with no damage or repairs - there is minimal gilding wear as expected with age and use to the rims.
