LOT 1559

An Empire shape Coalport porcelain trio, circa 1820, pattern No. 900, painted in iron red and gilding with foliate scrollwork, together with a group of pottery and porcelain, including six Royal Worcester cups and saucers in the Royal Lily pattern and a delft vase painted in blue with birds amidst flowers, height 36cm (faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Coalport trio - each piece with crazing to the glaze, the coffee cup has a small chip to the exterior rim edge.
Delft vase - broken and visibly repaired through neck at bottom of vase shaped section above shoulders of main vase.

Royal Lily cups and saucers - 5 saucers crazed but ok, 2 saucers ok, one saucer cracked. One cup badly broken, another with minor vertical haircrack.

Worcester plate mounted mustard - worn gilt rim, otherwise ok.

Floral painted teacup and saucer above turquoise vertical stripes - saucer crazed with minor staining, short vertical haircrack to cup.

Pottery teacup and saucer - stained and crazed but ok.
