A silver mounted mottled tiger glaze stoneware jug, circa 1600, the bulbous body on a small flared foot beneath the narrow cylindrical neck, the mounted rim with a band of scrolling foliage, with a loop handle, height 18cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

The jug itself would appear to be in good condition, the silver mounts have losses particularly around the handle area where the lack of glaze is visible where the mounts are likely to have gone.
