A garniture of three glass baskets, circa 1900, in the style of Moser, each clear body of flattened oval shape raised on a waisted stem and domed foot, enamelled with fish amidst weeds and flowers, tallest 26cm, smaller pair 21.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Large basket - small inconsequential chip to the top of one of the feet, otherwise in good condition.

First small basket - minor chipping to two of the feet.

Second small basket - chipping to three of the four feet and a minor nick to the side edge of the overhead handle.

Overall the enamelling in good order.
