### LOT 1656

A Swansea porcelain London shape part service, circa 1820, painted in the manner of Pollard, with wild flowers and fruit beneath a foliate scroll gilt rim border heightened with green enamelled flowerheads and dots, comprising seven teacups, six coffee cups, eighteen saucers, a circular pot with gilt lion's head and ring handles, height 10cm, one plate 25.8cm diameter, and six plates 20.8cm diameter, one of the six plates with impressed 'SWANSEA' mark (faults).

Estimate: £250 - £350

### Condition Report

25.8cm plate - in good condition.

six 20.8cm plates - 3 badly cracked, the other 3 fundamentally ok but with light surface scratches and one of these has wear to the gilding.

Circular pot - probably lacking cover (?), small starcrack to side of body, gilding around top of foot totally worn.

Saucers - 6 ok, 10 heavily crazed but ok, 2 cracked.

Teacups - 5 are in fundamentally good condition but with some wear and surface scratches, one is badly cracked and chipped, one is cracked.

Coffee cups - 2 have crazing but are ok, one is missing its handle, 2 have short haircracks, one is crazed with a minor haircrack.
