LOT 1649

A mixed group of English porcelain cabinet cups and saucers, 19th and 20th century, including a Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester example with oeil-de-perdrix pattern in puce and green within gilt framing, a two-handled Japan pattern cup with gilt handles, height 6.5cm, Aynsley, Coalport, Davenport and Minton (some faults).

Condition Report

Two-handled Imari decorated cup - vertical haircrack to rim.

Flight, Barr, Barr cup and saucer with oeil-de-perdrix - minor chip to underside rim edge of saucer, cup ok, typical light wear overall.

Flight cup and saucer with gilt fruiting vine and pink - significant wear but ok.

Pair pink and gilt Flight saucers - two small chips to underside rim edge of one, wear.

Aynsley cup and saucer with pink roses and blue rim - ok.

Minton pink ground cup, saucer and plate with pink roses to the rim - cup crazed, very minor wear, generally ok.

Orange banded two cups and one saucer with pink roses - saucer crazed with light staining, one cup ok with wear, other cup crazed with a small chip to rim and foot.

Royal Albert pink rose cup and saucer - ok.

Three various cups and a saucer with large pink roses - the Davenport cup is crazed but otherwise each piece is ok.

Pink ground trio with ropetwist handles - saucer chipped and cracked, light wear and scratches to coffee cup.

Cup and saucer with pink flowers - saucer cracked, short hairline to cup.

Cup and saucer with blue convolvulus - cup crazed with light staining, otherwise ok.

Royal Grafton trio - ok.

Aynsley saucer with gilt fleur-de-lys - ok.

Cup and saucer with gilt edged pink tear shaped panels - wear but ok.

Paris type saucer - ok.

Paris type can with high scroll handle - crack to upper handle terminal, light wear.
