A Royal Copenhagen Blue Flower Curved pattern part service, 1960s, comprising six dinner plates 26cm diameter, twelve dessert plates 20cm diameter, five tea plates 17.8cm diameter, four small dishes 13.5cm diameter, a pair of two-handled sucriers and covers, a pair of pierced oval baskets length 26cm, a pierced oval dish length 26.5cm, four small butter dishes, two salts, a pepper, candlestick and a pair of match holders, various green printed, underglaze blue and painted marks to bases (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Two baskets - marked as factory seconds, overall in good condition with a couple of minuscule nicks to the applied petals/leaves of the handle terminals, very inconsequential and only visible on very close inspection.

The two salts and the pepper have some tiny chips around the pierced holes.

Largest plates - one has a very long haircrack, another has a minuscule nick to the underside rim edge, not really noticeable from the upper edge.

Tea plates - one has a small chip to the underside rim edge.

Two handled sucriers and covers - one is cracked.

Four small dishes - one is badly chipped.

Dessert plates - one is chipped.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
