"A small group of John Walsh Walsh mostly straw opalescent uranium glass rustic thorn posy vases, late 19th century, of trunk form on root style feet, height of tallest 15.3cm, together with a small group of other opalescent and uranium glass and similar posy vases, including some of shaded cranberry tint with applied pulled rigaree uranium detail (minor faults).

Condition Report

Two of the rustic thorn posy vases have faults, 3 are ok.
The uranium branch like sculpture is missing an element.
Clear leaf shape ok.
Blue trunk vase ok.
Green trunk with pair of hooks ok.
Shaded pink square shaped vase with 2 small chips to top rim edge and inconsequential chipping to foot.
Clear trunk vase ok.
3 small cranberry trunk vases - one missing very tip of trailing, one missing section of trailing, one with chips.
2 large cranberry trunk vases - tiny nicks to top rim edge of one.
