LOT 1840

A mixed group of glass, mostly 19th century, including two pale amethyst flacons of flattened shape, one with plated mounts, height 21cm, the other pewter mounts, a similar plate mounted brown glass example, a cranberry glass decanter with clear faceted stopper engraved with ferns, height 24cm, ten various clear stem wines with green bowls, a set of three cranberry decanters and twelve shot glasses held in a trefoil shaped basket, a part suite of gilt decorated glasses with two matching decanters and stoppers and a claret jug and stopper, and a set of four pale amber decanters and stoppers held in a square shaped basket (faults throughout).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Trefoil basket of decanters and glasses - one decanter missing stopper, the tot glasses are ok, the basket is missing some interior divisions.

3 18th century style opaque twist glasses each with small chips.

Amber decanters in basket - one of the decanters is cracked through the body, another is cracked through the handle, the whiskey stopper is cracked.

The brown glass flask is missing a stopper.

The amethyst flask with plated stopper is missing a section of the neck which is hidden by the stopper.

Bristol blue glass decanter is missing a stopper and the gilt labelling is completely worn.

Bristol blue glass wine has a badly chipped foot.

Clear decanter and stopper has a chipped end to the stopper.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition with no damage or repairs.
