LOT 1596

A large pair of Coalport Imari decorated vases and covers, early 19th century, of tapered hexagonal shape with gilt dolphin head handles, the domed covers with gilt Buddhistic lion dogs, unmarked, height 40cm (restored).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

Both pots are fundamentally in good order but with restoration to the neck rims. Both have crazing to the glaze. Staining to the base interior of one.

One cover seems to have been broken in two, but is extensively restored to the underside with some minor repainting to the upper surface and a poorly matched re-gilt finial.

The other cover is more extensively broken and thoroughly restored to the underside with repainting and regilding to the surface, not very well executed. Again the finial is re-gilt but poorly matched.

There may be other issues with the finials, but the re-gilding makes it difficult to establish this.
