A Royal Worcester porcelain inkwell, liner and cover, dated 1863, the circular ivory glazed body moulded with three brown glazed masks alternating with three polychrome enameled and gilt caryatid supports with paw feet, raised on a shaped base, green printed factory mark, height 11cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

2 minuscule nicks to finial of cover, fairly inconsequential.

One base corner has a small chip to it which would seem to have been there since manufacture as it has been gilded over by the factory.

Otherwise in good condition with very minor typical wear to the gilding.
