A Nast Paris porcelain cabinet cup and saucer, early 19th century, the can shaped cup and saucer both painted en grisaille with a Classical female muse on a pink ground within a gilt framed diamond shaped panel and gilt painted berried fine foliage, against a wide band of gilt foliate scrollwork with cornucopia terminals, gilt painted marks to bases with old collector's labels to base of cup, diameter of saucer 12.7cm.

There is some crazing visible to the base interior of the can and some light wear to the cavetto of the saucer.
