A mixed group of English pottery and porcelain, 19th century, comprising a Bloor Derby two-handled rectangular footed bowl painted with a named scene 'View In Shropshire', red printed and painted marks to base, 29.5cm long, a Derby porter mug painted with a named scene 'View In Italy', red painted marks to base, height 13cm (starcrack to base), a Staffordshire dish painted with a landscape view, probably Lambton Castle, against a blue ground, length 35.5cm, two Derby campana shaped vases, one painted with a view (restored), the other Imari decoration, 17cm high, and other similar wares (faults).

Condition Report

Bloor Derby two-handled footed bowl - in good condition overall, there is a teeny tiny nick to the underside edge of one corner and a minuscule haircrack to another corner, both only visible on VERY close inspection. The gilding and enamels are overall good.

Pale blue bordered rectangular tray - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Derby Porter mug - View in Italy, starcrack to base, very minor 1cm vertical haircrack to rim, some staining to interior, overall not in terrible condition at all.

Derby Imari campana vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, some very typical light rubbing to gilding commensurate with age and handling.

Other campana vase with view - no factory mark just painted '39', restored through stem of foot with some regilding to edge of foot, otherwise ok.

Floral decorated part service - probably Spode - two handled dish with area of professional restoration to one corner, 2 hexagonal dishes one is badly broken and restored and the other is worn, 5 hexagonal plates one is badly broken and restored and the others are ok but with varying degrees of wear.

Leaf shaped dish with flowers and butterflies - unmarked, generally ok but with light wear.

Shaped rectangular dish painted with pink roses - worn and badly cracked to one end, unmarked.

Pair Mason's ironstone dishes - one crazed but otherwise both ok.

Pair of ironstone plates - ok

Mason's plate - worn and chipped.

Pink and gilt shaped plate - marked '565', light wear but ok.

3 green ground plates - marked 828 B, all ok.

Floral cup and saucer - unmarked, cup crazed otherwise ok.

Matching coffee cup and teacup - unmarked, coffee ok, tea crazed and stained.
