Condition Report

The main body is very badly cracked, this includes part of the lower handle, with some small losses along the crack/break lines. There is a corresponding large section of the foot which has been broken off and restored back with losses and chips along the break line and to the surrounding area. There are some chips to the outer edges of the handle.

There is an oblong shaped hole to the main body to the side of the coat of arms.
