LOT 1855

An Orrefors glass decanter and stopper, mid-20th century, engraved with a design after Nils Landberg depicting a mermaid holding a shell, engraved marks to base, height 25cm, together with a mixed group of Swedish glass, comprising five engraved Strombergshyttan vases, tallest 18.5cm, four Holmegaard vases designed by Per Lutken, a Kjellender vase engraved with a ship in sail, height 21cm, an engraved Edenfalk vase, two other engraved vases and a decanter and stopper engraved with a bird in flight, various engraved marks to bases (some faults).
Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

One of the smaller pair of Holmegaard green tint vases has a chip to the top rim edge.

Smallest unmarked vase engraved with three flowers on a stem has chips to the top rim edge.

Unmarked vase engraved with a diving fish has a minuscule nick to the top edge of one corner - hardly noticeable.

Stromberg vase engraved with a bird has a chip to the top rim edge.

Otherwise all items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
