A Coalport porcelain two-handled vase and cover, early 20th century, painted with fruiting vine within vertical green glazed stripes beneath orange 'jewelled' gilt borders, flanked by gilt scroll handles, the similarly 'jewelled' cover with gilt knob, green printed and painted marks to base, height 16cm, together with a Royal Worcester coffee pot, dated 1931, painted by Shuck, signed, with still life fruit studies (lacking cover, restored), and a pair of Caughley blue printed coffee cups.

Condition Report

Coalport - overall fine crazing to the glaze, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Worcester pot - lacking cover, 2 restored vertical cracks to body.

Caughley cups - both in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration, both with typical rubbing to gilding.
