An Omega Speedmaster Professional 'Moon Watch' Chronograph steel cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 145022-76, circa 1979, the signed and jewelled 861 caliber movement numbered '39923363', with dust cover, the signed black dial with luminous hour markers and three subsidiary dials, the case with black tachymeter scale bezel, the signed case back interior detailed '145022-76 ST', the case back with Speedmaster emblem and inscribed 'Flight qualified by NASA for all manned space missions, the first watch worn on the moon', the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case diameter 4cm.

Condition Report

1130. The watch is in generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear to case and bracelet, but no significant damage or repairs. Glass is heavily scratched, more significant wear to bezel at 5 o'clock. Dial appears in good order.

The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The chrono feature in good working order with both buttons working well and returning to upright/12 o'clock.
