An Omega Seamaster Quartz gilt metal fronted and steel backed gentleman's wristwatch, Ref. 1342, circa 1978, the signed and jewelled 1342 caliber movement numbered '43609952', the signed charcoal grey textured dial with gilt baton hour markers and date aperture, the case back numbered '1342', the signed case back interior numbered '196.0167' over '396.0888', the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case width 3.2cm, with red case and International guarantee booklet.

Condition Report

1129. Generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. There is some gapping between one of the end links and the next link where it looks like one on the pins is missing/damaged, so would require attention.

Dial in good clean order. Hands adjust and date rolls over as it should. Currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Bracelet length including closed clasp approx. 15cm, clasp a little tight but in working order.
