A Universal Genève Tri-Compax Triple Calendar stainless steel circular cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, Ref. 22297 3, circa 1950s, with unsigned jewelled 281 caliber movement, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, four subsidiary dials for date with moonphase, seconds, 30-minute and 12-hour registers, and day and month apertures, the case back numbered '22297 3' above '1803233', case diameter 3.4cm, on a brown leather strap.

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## Condition Report

1148. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to case. Dial in generally good order with some dirt specks, minor scratches and wear. Missing inner movement dust cover.

Winds and adjusts smoothly, day and date roll over as they should, and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Chrono feature in working order with both buttons on right side of case starting, stopping and resetting to upright as they should. The smaller setting buttons to left side of case do depress but do not appear to be working.
