1123. Memosail - case and glass are dirty, heavily scratched and worn, no winder so does not wind or run. Emperor - typical scratches and wear to case and glass. Winds and adjusts smoothly and day and date roll over as they should, and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Seiko - winds and adjusts smoothly, day and date roll over as they should. Dial in good order, typical light surface scratches and wear to case.

All with replacement bracelets, otherwise the watches appear to all be original, but please be aware it is almost impossible to be absolutely certain of all parts originality.

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
