A late 19th/early 20th century French brass carriage clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the corniche case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height 17.5cm.

Condition Report

1214. Clock is in generally good order. The case has typical surface scratches and wear. Dial in good order. Glass panels in good order except for the back door which has small chips to two corners. The going train does not wind and it only runs for 5-10 seconds before stopping. The strike mechanism train winds smoothly, strike mechanism and repeat in working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
