A late 19th/early 20th century French gilt metal mounted and veined marble clock garniture, the portico clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with urn surmount and turned columns, on a rectangular base, height 40cm, with pendulum, flanked by a pair of matching urns, height 26.4cm.

Condition Report

1253. The garniture is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. A little dusty so would certainly benefit from a clean. Otherwise typical light surface scratches, minor nicks to edges of marble and light wear. Small hairline crack to dial. Glass front door and hinge good. Missing cover to case back. The movement winds smoothly, strike mechanism is working and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
