A gold, silver set and diamond brooch, designed as an anchor, mounted with old cut cushion shaped diamonds, unmarked, weight 5.6g, width 4.3cm.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

610. Overall generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. The old cut cushion shaped diamonds are attractive white stones, some have internal pique inclusions. Hinge pin is a little wobbly, but otherwise working and appears to be secure when closed. The diamonds are set in a silver fronted setting, the colour to the back would suggest the gold backing to be approximately 9ct. Suggested age - last quarter of the 19th century (1875-1900). Length 4.2cm.

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
