A German gold and agate cameo brooch, 19th century, carved as a portrait of a lady, mounted with a floral and foliate rose cut diamond, ruby and sapphire set spray motif to one side, unmarked, weight 28.7g, width 4cm, with the original case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

575. The brooch is in very good clean condition. The carving is crisp. The gold mount is in good order and the stones are bright and vibrant. Small diamond set crescent at the very bottom of the mount which is set in a silver metal rather than gold (whether this is part of the original design or not is difficult to say) and there is a screw behind securing it.

The case is in poor condition with broken hinge, wear and scratches.

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
