A pair of George III Neoclassical beech showframe elbow chairs, upholstered in green foliate patterned damask, the palmette carved top rails above fluted and bellflower embellished frames, height 97cm, width 62cm, depth 62cm (the frames probably formerly painted or gilded).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2011. There are a few small repairs around joints on both chairs, one chair with let-in repairs to the rear of the top rail joints and the other chair with a few small repairs around the front leg joint. There is some minor scattered woodworm and a general overall wear to the frame. One chair has slightly reduced rear legs with worn down tips.
