### LOT 1021

A Chinese famille verte biscuit porcelain jar and cover, late Qing dynasty, of ovoid form, moulded in relief with a crane amidst lotus on a turquoise ground, height 28cm (drilled through cover and impressed seal mark to base, cover repaired and rim chips), with carved hardwood stand.

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

1021. Cover has been broken into 10 pieces and glue repaired. Some chips/losses along breaks. Drilled hole to top of cover and base of jar where once mounted as a table lamp.

Jar with 1.2cm and 2.5cm 'U' shaped chip to rim and smaller 1cm x 1cm chip to rim. Otherwise jar is in generally good condition with no other cracks or repairs. Colours are good, relief decoration is good.

Wood stand has a small repair to one side.
