A Chinese famille noir enameled biscuit porcelain jar, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, of lobed ovoid form, moulded in relief with a band of immortals picked out in aubergine, yellow and green beneath a similarly coloured ruyi-head collar, all against a black glazed ground, black enamelled seal mark to base, height 24.3cm (faint star crack to base).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1022. Generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. There is a faint hairline star crack to base, but no visible to interior. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Decoration is good. Painted seal mark to base good.
