A Chinese silk embroidered rectangular panel, late Qing dynasty, worked in coloured threads with a peacock, a pair of red-capped cranes and other birds amidst blossoming branches and flowers on a black ground, 113cm x 73cm, framed and glazed.

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## Condition Report

1039. Generally good condition, with no significant damage or repairs. Some minor unstitching and wear to some branches to the centre and upper left side of the panel. Silk has some minor horizontal ripping where it is not attached to its backing quite tight enough. Stitching otherwise good and colours are good. Framed and glazed.

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
