A group of three Chinese blue and white export porcelain coffee cups, Qianlong period, painted with pavilions in a coastal landscape with gilt enriched detail, height 6.6cm, and a similar Chinese famille rose decorated coffee cup and teabowl (some faults), together with two Worcester porcelain coffee cups, circa 1770, each painted with Chinese figures, height 6.3cm.

Condition Report

1083. 1 blue and white cup - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs other than a tiny chip to footrim.

2 blue and white cups - both with professionally restored handles, otherwise good.

Famille rose cup - restored handle and paint is starting to flake, otherwise good.

Famille rose teabowl - broken into seven pieces and repaired, and rim chips. Typical wear to enamels.

Both English cups in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze, gilt and enamels.
