A Chinese blue and white export porcelain ginger jar, Kangxi period, the ovoid body painted with prunus on a cracked ice ground, height 12.2cm (faint minor hairline to rim), with carved and pierced hardwood cover.

### Condition Report

1002. Generally good condition, there is a faint 1.2cm hairline crack visible to the inside of the rim, which is not obviously noticeable to outside of rim. Typical light surface scratches and some minor glaze blemishes. Hardwood cover with a couple of minor shrinkage cracks, but otherwise ok.
