A Chinese blue and white porcelain jar, Kangxi period, of stoutly potted ovoid form, painted with a uniform design of lotus flowerheads and scrolling tendrils, beneath a short neck with foliate band, height 41.7cm (faint star hairline crack to body), together with a carved and pierced hardwood domed cover (damaged and repaired).

Estimate: £2,000 - £4,000

Condition Report

1100. Generally good condition, star crack to one side (see images 27/30 and 28/30 on our website). Small chip to rim and rim may have been ground down slightly. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze.

Good vibrant blue decoration.

Wood cover in poor condition.
