### LOT 1031

A Japanese Satsuma earthenware koro and cover, Meiji period, with lion finial, the globular body painted and gilt with figures within simulated brocade borders, on tripod legs, height 44.5cm (cover repaired), together with a Japanese Kutani porcelain vase, Meiji period, painted and gilt with goose and swallows above Buddhist lions, brocade balls and flowers, height 33.5cm.

### Condition Report

1031. Satsuma koro - the cover has been broken into numerous pieces and reglued. Some chipping and losses along break lines. Lion finial with restoration to tail and back. The body of the koro is in generally good condition with only minor nicks to rim, typical light crazing to glaze and wear to enamels and gilt. Two small firing cracks to feet and some minor staining to glaze near to base.

Kutani vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt.
