Three Moorcroft limited edition ginger jars and covers from the Shakespearean series, designed by Rachel Bishop and Sally Tuffin, produced for B & W Thornton Stratford-On-Avon, comprising the King Lear pattern, dated 1994, No. 235 of 250, Ophelia pattern, dated 1992, No. 126 of 250, and Midsummer Night's Dream, dated 1991, No. 67 of 250, each with impressed, printed and painted marks to base, all 15cm high (small fault to last).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

King Lear and Ophelia examples are both in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Neither have crazing.

The Midsummer example has crazing to the glaze of the jar and cover and a vertical firing crack to the upright neck rim which is hidden when the cover is in place.
