A Limoges porcelain part dessert service, early 20th century, decorated with Art Nouveau style enamelled and gilt flowers against a shaded green/pink pastel ground within gilt overlaid cobalt blue borders with shaped rim edges, comprising a tazza, two low stands and six plates, diameter 21.5cm, printed 'GDA' marks to bases.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Small chip to upper edge of one low stand at 12 o'clock.

The tazza has some minor and indistinct glaze flaking to the stamens of the main flower - only noticeable on very close inspection.

Otherwise each piece is in good condition.

Some typical light rubbing to the gilding commensurate with age and handling.
